Phyllis is a certified biblical counselor, and for years she brought Christ-centered direction and encouragement to distressed women in all kinds of places – in jails, in public areas, at home, or wherever God led her.

By January 2013 Phyllis realized that she needed to formalize her ministry and to establish a base from which to mentor an increasing number of women who were asking for help. Two years later she pulled together her vision and made it a reality when she and her staunch ally, Pat Adkins, opened a non-profit center for women called Kitchen Table Conversations in suite 416 at The Guilford Building.

Building Office Closing in June

Diana Poston will be traveling in June, and the business office will be closed most of the time while she is gone. Her last day will be Friday, June 12; her return date is Monday, June 29.

What does this mean to you?

- ◆ You will need your keys. It is unlikely that you will be able to borrow keys or get help to enter the building or your premises while Diana is away.
- ◆ You will need a current parking permit. Parking permits will not be issued during Diana's absence. If you find that you do not have a current permit in your vehicle, look for metered parking across Davie Street in the City/Depot lot.
- ◆ You can leave rent payments, notes, keys, etc. in the locked mail box beside the business office door, and they will be picked up daily.
- ◆ You can schedule the conference room through Fonzie at the front desk.
- ◆ You will have the care and services of The Guilford Building Staff, so non-administrative matters will be addressed as usual. And of course, the staff always will assist you in case of emergency.
