Thank you for your patience during the recent sidewalk disruption on the north side of the building in front of The Locke Alterations Shop. A team contracted by Spirit Communications removed a section of sidewalk in order to insert a new underground hand hole box. A hand hole box, also known as a pull box, is a readily accessible enclosure used for pulling, splicing, and storing telecommunications cable.

Spirit Communications ran fiber optic cable into the new hand hole, through the side wall of the basement, and finally up to the 6th floor of the building where the company maintains a telecommunications facility. This new fiber optic installation enables Spirit to double its data transmission and voice communication capabilities.

Spirit Communications, previously PalmettoNet, has been located on the 6th floor of The Guilford Building for nearly 20 years.
