Weaver Investment Company owns those parking areas and now is exploring new ways to develop the property.

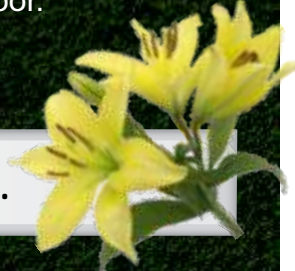


10TH FLOOR TO OPEN MARCH 18
